

AMERICAN EDUCATION SYSTEM

USA has the world's most flexible education system. Students can study in their area of interest as a specialization. As the education system of USA is not centralized each institute can determine its program and admission standards. Lateral movement in the education system is possible at any time.



TYPES OF DEGREES

- 1. Associate Degree: It is an academic degree awarded by the community colleges, junior colleges, and business colleges. Usually for two years (60 credits). In the USA, an associate degree is equivalent to the first two years of a four year college or university Bachelors degree. It is the lowest in hierarchy of post secondary academic degrees offered in USA. Students need to appear for TOEFL/IELTS/PTE.
- 2. Bachelors Degree: Commonly known as an Undergraduate degree in India. The duration of the bachelors course is 4 years (120-150 credits). Students who have completed a part of their undergraduate degree and want to go to USA, can apply as a transfer student. There are two types of bachelors degree: B.A or B.S. Some universities in the USA offer either of the degrees in all fields and at times both the degrees in some fields. Students need to appear for SAT or ACT & TOEFL/IELTS/PTE for admission.
- 3. Masters Degree: The duration of master's courses may range from a year or two depending on the university & your area of specialization (30-48 credits). The binding requisite for Masters is 16 year of education. Students with Bachelors in engineering are qualified whereas the students with

B.Com, B.Sc and B.A. might need to complete at least one year of Masters. Postgraduate diploma is also accepted by some institutions for specific programs. Some universities have started accepting students with a 3 year Bachelors degree i.e. BCom, BSc, BA, etc into their MSc, MA or MBA degree. Exams required are GMAT for management related subjects / GRE for arts, science or any other subjects and TOEFL / IELTS / PTE for admission.

- Doctorate: Commonly known as PhD. Duration may range from 3 years to 5 years. Students can take admission for a PhD after completion of their master's degree. PhD students need to submit a research proposal as well as have to appear for GRE/GMAT & TOEFL/IELTS/PTE for admission.
- 5. Summer Program : Study Programs take place during the months of summer vacation. They usually last for six to ten weeks depending on the school and the course of study. Most summer schools offer a wide variety of courses. Students, who wish to explore courses outside their major, or simply accelerate their degree program, attend Summer Program. TOEFL, IELTS or PTE is usually required.

UNIVERSITIES IN USA

Types of Institutions

Public Universities: These are State-affiliated Institutions financially supported by public taxes and are usually large in size. They normally offer all levels of degrees and many different fields of study. Tuition fees are usually less compared to Private institutions. Examples: Pennsylvania State University, Ohio State University, University of California, Kansas State University, University of Texas, etc.

Private Institutions: : A private university runs without the control of any government entity. Tuition fees at private universities tend to be much higher than at public universities, Examples: Long Island University, George Washington University, New York University, Carnegie Mellon University, etc.



Technical Institutes: These are schools specializing primarily in engineering and science and particularly known for their research and graduate programs. Example: M.I.T. (the Massachusetts Institute of Technology), Cal Poly (California Polytechnic Institute), Georgia Tech (Georgia Institute of Technology), NYIT (New York Institute of Technology) and W.P.I. (Worcester Polytechnic Institute), etc.

The lvy League: These schools are among the oldest and most famous in the country. Members of the lvy League are: Harvard, Yale, Princeton, Brown, Dartmouth, Cornell, Columbia, and the University of Pennsylvania. All these schools are in the Northeastern part of the USA. Ivy League colleges stress undergraduate liberal arts education, but they also have Noted graduate and professional schools. Tuition at these private schools is among the highest in the country and admission is highly competitive.

Small Liberal Arts Colleges: These Schools focus on undergraduate study of the traditional arts and sciences disciplines: i.e. Humanities, Sciences, and Social Sciences. Strictly liberal arts colleges are often quite old and are usually private schools. These colleges are highly-rated institutions because they stress on small classes, individual attention for their students, and a close relationship between the faculty and students. Examples: Amherst, Marist, Swarthmore, Manhattan, Smith, Mount Holyoke, Marietta, Bryn Mawr, Oberlin, Grinnell, etc.

Community Colleges: More over known as County College or City College is an educational institution providing higher education and lower-level tertiary education, granting certificates, diplomas and Associates' degrees. Example: Bellevue Community College, Ohlone College, De Anza Colleges, etc.

GRADING SYSTEM IN USA

The GPA (Grade Point Average) system is followed throughout the United States to judge a student's performance. It is graded in the scale of 0 to 4. To convert the percentage into the GPA, a credential evaluation needs to be done. Accurate GPA helps in quicker decision and scholarship.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission to USA universities and colleges can be very competitive. Each university / department has its own admission requirements for the course of study selected. Successful admission for International students to a top USA school requires ample amount of preparation & research. The admission process should ideally begin at least 6-18 months before your expected arrival in the USA. Organizing and planning are the two vital aspects as timely completion of all the necessary steps is key.

ADMISSION TEST EXAMINATIONS

START DATE

US universities have 2 intakes :

- I) Fall: August/September
- 2) Spring: January/February/March

Major intake is th e Fall intake, but most of the universities are open for Spring and few of them for Summer & Winter intake too.

SAT is based on a 1600-point scale, with 2 sections-Math and Evidence-Based Reading & Writing 1250 score is considered a Good Score. **GRE** is based on a 340 -point scale, with 2 sections-Verbal Reasoning and Quantitative Reasoning. The Analytical Writing section is scored on a scale of 0-6. 310 score is considered a Good Score.

GMAT is based on a 800-point scale, with 2 sections-Quantitative Reasoning and Verbal Reasoning sections. The Integrated Reasoning (IR) section is graded on a scale of 0-8, and the Analytical Writing Assessment (AWA) is graded on a scale of 0-6. 550 score is considered a Good Score.






ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

All students must have the required English Language Proficiency with regards to the course. TOEFL score of 80-90 for Postgraduate and 70-80 for Undergraduate studies is a decent score. IELTS score of 6-6.5 for Undergraduates and 6.5-7 band for Postgraduate studies is required. Over 3000 institutions in USA recognize the IELTS & PTE exam including several top ranked institutions.

RANKING AND ACCREDITATION

Rankings are subjective to quality, combination of statistics or surveys by educators, scholars, students or others. In addition to rankings of institutions, there are also rankings of specific academic programs, departments and schools. Rankings are conducted by magazines newspapers and in some instances by academic practitioners. There is No Official Ranking system in USA. Ranking is not the only factor to be considered while choosing a university.

Accreditation is another factor that one must consider. Accreditation assures the quality of the post secondary education the student receives. It is simply an assurance that a program or institution meets established quality standards normally given by an academic body or association. LIVING EXPENSES

When calculating the cost of education, living expenses play a critical role. On an average, a student spends approx 15000 - 18000/year. But the expenses also depend on the place where a student stays i.e. if a student stays in metropolitan city like New York, San Francisco, Manhattan, etc the expenses could go up to 20000/year in comparison to a student studying in a suburban area where the expenses are around 12000 to 15000/year.

ACCOMMODATION

Most of the educational institutions will assist you in finding accommodation while studying in the USA. Accommodation are of two types i.e. a student can stay on campus (Halls of Residence/Students hostel) or Off Campus (Home stay, Apartments/Flats). Staying Off Campus is much cheaper as compared to staying On Campus but it is always advisable that a student must stay on campus for the first six months.

SCHOLARSHIP/ FINANCIAL AID

Fee waivers are awarded to international students on the criteria of merit & need. Candidates with strong academics, good performance on standardized exams & extra curricular achievements are eligible for scholarships, awards & financial assistance. To benefit from these opportunities, one has to send all the required documents by particular deadlines. In addition to this, the presentation of the application package is also important because one is judged by the image one projects.





There are various types of Scholarships:

- Fellowship-Scholarship: This is usually offered on the student's ability, competence & performance.
- Assistantship: Generally involves a teaching or research assistantship. Students receive aid, in the form of cash stipend or a tuition fee waiver or reduced tuition fee.
- Sports Scholarship: Though seldom offered to international students, athletic or sports scholarships are available to a wide range of outstanding and talented athletes.

PART TIME JOBS ON CAMPUS/ WORK AFTER COURSE

International students can take up campus jobs. They are allowed to work 20 hrs per week during a semester (on campus). On campus jobs may include teaching assistantship or research assistantship where a student is paid \$8 to \$10 per hour. Thus student earns \$ 500-\$ 600 per month or can get a waiver in tuition fees. With this, a student can also do an internship in the related field which may be paid. During vacation the student is allowed to work for 40 hrs per week. On completion of the course, the student is allowed to work for 1 yr popularly known as OPT (Optional Practical Training). Students with certain degrees in a STEM(Science, Technology, Engineering an Mathematics) field are allowed to work for 36 months. On completion of the their OPT, the student can later apply on a H1B visa (work permit visa) for work.

- Q. What is the transfer student concept?
- A transfer option is to complete at least I to 2 years of the Bachelors / Diploma program in any country and then apply for a transfer to the University that a student wants to attend in USA. The years waived off in your transfer status will depend on the courses covered in India and the grades for the same. It is rare to get the exact transfer of credits.
- Q. Should I apply only to Top Ten Universities?
- The acceptance ratio of top ten Universities are only 1% 4%. Therefore, in order to improve your chances of admission, you should also Α. apply to other Universities that offer good programs. The entry requirements are extremely stringent for such institutions. One must always remember that Rankings can be world wide, region based and even subject based. If one is looking for a ranked university, the search should be subject based.

Q. I have completed 15 years of education in India. Can I get admission for MBA directly in the USA?

A. Most American Universities require 16 years of education for admission into an MBA or any other Graduate program. It is therefore advisable to complete M.Com / M.A/ M.Sc. or at least one year of any Masters Degree before taking admission in an American University. Some top ranked Universities can take you with 15 yrs. of education with 2-3 years of relevant work experience.
